SPORTS FEES

- 6th grade athletes
\$30.00 for each sport
- 7th-12th grade athletes
\$50.00 for each sport



Sports fees **MUST** be paid and physical forms completed before a student may participate in any sport.

RECOMMENDATIONS

For every new student you recommend to us in grades K3-12, who attend a full school year, we will give you \$100 credit on your May tuition. HOT LUNCH PROGRAM

Our school provides a hot lunch program. A menu is sent home monthly for your convenience. You may purchase a full lunch, main entrée, or first item on the menu. A full lunch is \$2.50, a main entrée is \$2.00 (elementary only), and first item is \$1.50. Secondary may order from the a la carte menu. Drinks are available for \$.50. (A drink is included with the full lunch.) A ticket for full lunches may be purchased for \$25.00 for 10 lunches. A main ticket may be purchased for \$20.00 for 10 mains. Microwaves are available for your child to warm dishes brought from home.
