

# THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW

### SPORTS FEES

- 6th grade athletes  
\$65.00 for each sport
- 7th-12th grade athletes  
\$75.00 for each sport



Sports fees **MUST** be paid and physical forms completed before a student may participate in any sport. When a sport is finished, please return clean uniforms to your coach washed and in a bag with the student's name on it. Students with unreturned uniforms will have their report cards held.

### RECOMMENDATIONS

For every new student you recommend to us in grades K3-12 who attend a full school year, we will give you \$100 credit on your May tuition. If you encourage 10 others to come for this next year, you'll receive \$1,000. Please inform those you recommend to list your name on the top of their application. It is our prayer and desire to give every young person the opportunity of a Christian education. Please help us to help other families. In so doing, you will receive some extra savings on your tuition. The financial office needs to know at the beginning of the school year in order to give you the credit. ### HOT LUNCH PROGRAM

Our school provides a hot lunch program. A menu is sent home monthly for your convenience. You may purchase a full lunch, main entrée, or first item on the menu. A full lunch is \$2.75, a main lunch is \$2.25 (elementary only-first 2 items on menu), and first item is \$1.75 except pizza is \$1.50. Secondary may order from the a la carte menu. Drinks are available starting at \$.50. (A drink is included with the full lunch.) A ticket for full lunches may be purchased for \$27.50 for 10 lunches. A main ticket may be purchased for \$22.50 for 10 mains. Microwaves are available for your child to warm dishes brought from home.

Attendance is required for parents (one or both) of students entering grades 1-12. Valuable information is given that will be helpful for the entire school year. Elementary students do not need to attend. Secondary students are encouraged to attend.

### FIELD TRIPS
